## Five Point Activities

<b>Across and Down</b> Write each of your spelling words across and then down. Example: ELF L F	<b>Upper and Lower</b> Write your spelling words and then rewrite each word. This time write the vowels in lowercase letters and the consonants in uppercase letters. Example: lower LoWeR	<b>Connect the Dots</b> Write your spelling words in dots and then connect them by tracing over the dots with colored pencil or crayon. Example: present present
<b>December Scene</b> Draw a picture of a holiday scene and hide all of your spelling words in your picture! Don't forget to make it colorful and detailed!	<b>Add 'Em Up Words</b> Write each of your spelling words and then find out the value of each word. Consonants are worth 10 and vowels are worth 5. Example: present $10+10+5+10+5+10+10=60$	<b>Scrambled Words</b> Write each of your spelling words and then write them again with the letters all mixed up. Example: cookies kocosei

Include across and down clues for each of your words.	<b>Silly Sentence Spelling</b> Write each of your spelling words in a silly sentence that shows you understand its meaning. Example: cookies: The gingerbread giraffe baked acacia leaf cookies for the holiday party.
